# DRIVING DIRECTIONS

#### From I-85 to Marriott Grand National

Exit 58 for U.S. 280 West toward Opelika

Pass TigerTown Shopping Center on left, stay on U.S. 280/Gateway Drive, keeping to the left

Go approximately 4 miles, crossing Pepperell Parkway

Right onto Grand National Parkway

Right onto Robert Trent Jones Trail, straight through all roundabouts

Marriott Grand National entrance will be on left

#### From Marriott Grand National to Mises Institute:

Exit the Marriott property and turn right onto Robert Trent Jones Trail

Go 1.1 miles, straight through all roundabouts

Left onto Grand National Parkway

Go 5.4 miles, crossing U.S. 280, and University Drive

Left at deadend onto College Street and go .08 miles, staying in right lane

Right onto Glenn Avenue and go .04 miles

Left onto Donahue, then next right onto Genelda

Left at stop sign. Mises Institute back and front parking lots will be on left after Rothbard Village

#### **From Mises Institute to Marriott Grand National**

Left out of front or back Institute parking lots

Left onto Magnolia Avenue

Left at second traffic light, onto College Street and go 1.1 miles

Right onto Shelton Mill Road

Go 5.4 miles, crossing U.S. 280, and University Drive

Right onto Robert Trent Jones Trail, straight through all roundabouts

Marriott Grand National entrance will be on left
